

Klickitat County's Rural Systems Need Funding Assistance

Work is on the fast track to bring all 13 of Klickitat PUD's (KPUD) water and wastewater systems into compliance with the latest regulations.

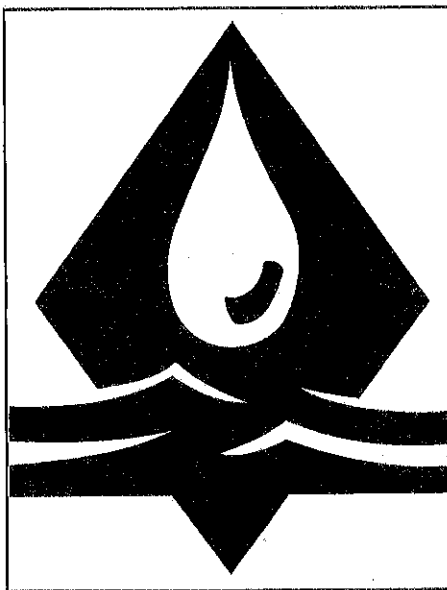
Customers of Klickitat County's small rural systems cannot afford to do the necessary work without the grants and loans it received from county, state and federal agencies.

Since 2002, approximately \$11 million has been awarded to KPUD in the form of 13 grants and six low-interest loans.

Grant and loan projects include improvements to the Roosevelt, Wishram, Lyle and Klickitat wastewater systems, the Roosevelt, Klickitat and Ponderosa water systems and a system-wide project to install source meters on all water systems.
