Allen and his wife have been residents of The Dalles the past nine years, so he is familiar with Klickitat County and KPUD projects.

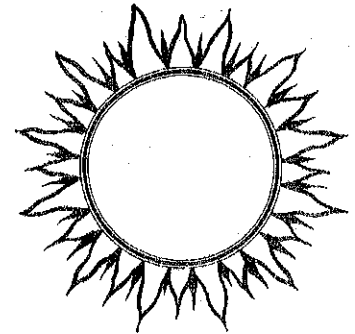

Solar Rebate Program Offered

Klickitat PUD is working to become less dependent on generation sources that may not be able to assure us enough power for our growing needs.

To this end, Klickitat PUD is looking for more local and renewable generation sources. In line with this vision, the PUD is pleased to offer customers a rebate program for solar installations.

Rebates are based on \$400 per kilowatt of installed rated output of the system. This goes up to a maximum of \$1,200, and must offset an existing electrical load.

Like Klickitat PUD's other rebate programs, financing for the installation is available at 4.9 percent for qualifying customers.
