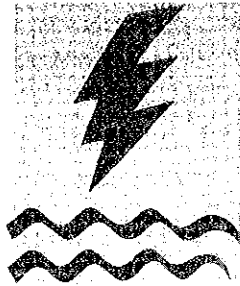


Low Income Elderly Discount Available

Klickitat PUD offers a Low Income Elderly Rate Discount for billings issued December 2004 through May 2005. The program is monitored through Klickitat County Senior Services, which determines eli-

gibility and provides the PUD with a list of eligible residential customers. If you are 62 or older and wish to take advantage of this discount, please contact Klickitat County Senior Services at the numbers listed below.

Discount	Yearly Income
40 percent	\$10,000 or less
30 percent	\$10,001-\$13,999
20 percent	\$14,000-\$16,999
10 percent	\$17,000-\$20,000

- Have a small amount added to your monthly KPUD bill. Most people give just \$1 or \$2 per month.
- Make a one-time contribution of any amount. All gifts are welcome.
- Place your bill in the Operation Round Up program, which rounds your utility bill up to the nearest dollar, and places the difference into the Operation Warm Heart fund to help needy families.
