Keep Power Poles Free of Debris

A wood power pole may seem like a great place to post your signs. However, it is illegal to do so in the state of Washington and, most importantly, it creates a danger to utility lineworkers.

Staples, tacks or nails used to attach signs to power poles can trip up a lineworker or pierce the worker's protective clothing or safety equipment, which could possibly result in injury or even electrocution.

Abuse of power poles can also cause premature damage and make it necessary to replace the poles.
