

## LFG Plant Runs Cleaner and Meaner

Klickitat PUD (KPUD) has completed the installation of a new gas cleaning system at the H.W. Hill Landfill Gas Power (LFG) Plant near Roosevelt that will provide cleaner gas to the engines.

The new cleaning system is designed to remove sand-like contaminants such as siloxane, which will dramatically lower the maintenance costs on the engines.

The cleaning tanks and piping were made in Sandy, Oregon, by Quality Tank Corporation and shipped by truck to the Roosevelt site.

Darby Hanson, KPUD's project engineer, and media supplier Calgon Carbon and Dubal & Associates Engineers designed and provided oversight during installation of the system.

Site Supervisor Rick Burk coordinated workgroups through a short 16-hour outage that was required to "tie-in" the new gas-cleaning system and complete other planned maintenance tasks.

The scheduled outage was successfully completed in the time

allotted, with a huge amount of work performed in one day.

The LFG plant is back in busi-

ness and generating at its full 10 megawatts capacity. ■

Customers who live out of town in the rural areas of the county are reminded to read your meters monthly. Without an accurate monthly reading, our computer "guesses" how much electricity you have used and produces an estimated billing.

Reading your meter is easy! Simply write down the numbers showing on your meter—left to right—the same way you read the odometer in your car.

Submit your reading to Klickitat PUD monthly, choosing **one** of the following options:

1. Record the date and meter reading on your bill stub and return it with your payment.
