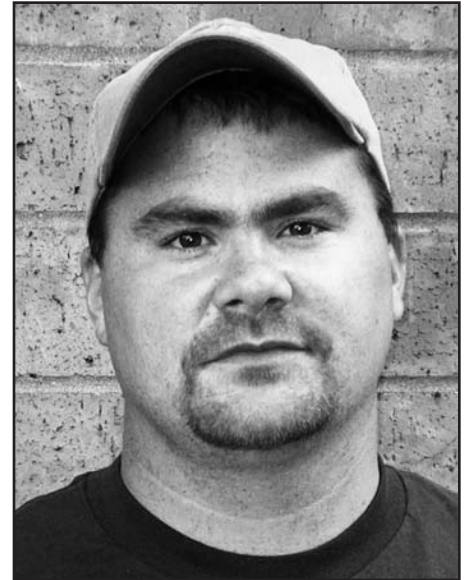
He says he has waited for an opportunity to join the department ever since.
